Notice of Race

1. Event

“Rondeau Yacht Club (RYC) Windsurfing Regatta”, July 3rd, 2010 at Rondeau Yacht Club, Rondeau Provincial Park, Ontario. The organizing authority is Windsurfing Canada in conjunction with Ontario Sailing and the Rondeau Yacht Club. Additional information on the regatta can be found at www.rondeauyachtclub.ca.

****Please note, as the regatta site is within a Provincial Park, all people entering the park shall be subject to the park entrance fee, and all rules and regulations set out by Ontario Parks.****

2. Rules and Regulations

This event will be governed by: The Funboard Racing Rules, the Formula Windsurfing Class Rules, and the IFCA Rules. The Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions will be available at time of registration. The Race Committee will be responsible for resolving any and all protests.

PFD's must be worn by competitors while on the water at all times.

3. Disciplines and Divisions

*(The top three (3) finishers in each discipline/division shall be recognized.)

1. Course Racing (Formula, Formula Experience, RSX, Bic 293, Race-Board, Prodigy)
2. Slalom (conditions permitting: 15knot minimum)
3. Freestyle (optional: time and conditions permitting)

“Open” Fleet

Men: Masters (45+), Men (19-44), Youth (18+ under)

Women: Masters (35+), Women (19-34), Youth (18+ under)

4. Registration, Eligibility, and Fees

Competitors must be members of Windsurfing Canada (WC) or, if visitors to Canada, of their national windsurfing authority. WC memberships will be available at the registration desk on site, and on-line at www.windsurfingcanada.com. Sail numbers must conform to WC size and placement specifications. Registered WC sail numbers shall have preference if there is a conflict. Tape (temporary) for Sail numbers will be available at time of registration. Advanced Registration will take place at the Rondeau Yacht Club (Regatta site) on July 2nd from 2pm to 4pm, and on the morning of the regatta (July 3rd) from 8am to 10am.

All competitors must check-in at the registration desk prior to the first race. Competitors who wish to pre-register may contact David French (frenchie97@teksavvy.com), and a registration form will be emailed to you. 7. Venue and Weather

The launch site is on Rondeau Bay, at the Rondeau Yacht Club, inside Rondeau Provincial Park. The Regatta site is sailable in all wind directions except east, and should an east wind be present, an alternate course may be set up (at discretion of the Race Committee) less than 2 minutes away on Lake Erie. The prevailing winds are southwest, and the site is ideal in this direction. Water temperatures at this time of year are generally mild, with anything from a ‘shorty’ to a bathing suit being necessary for personal protection. The rigging area is grass, with a sand shoreline, and sand bottom bay.

Also, at this time of year, Rondeau Bay is generally weed free. However, you should bring along a weed fin in case you feel the weeds may become an issue.

Rondeau Provincial Park is located on the north-western shore of Lake Erie, minutes from Highway 401. Driving time to Rondeau is approximately: 3 hours from Toronto, 1 hour from London, 1 hour from Windsor/Detroit, and 2 hours from Toledo.

8. Accommodation

There is ample camping within Rondeau Provincial Park camping (minutes from the race site) with electrical hook-ups available. Reservations are recommended and can be made through the Ontario

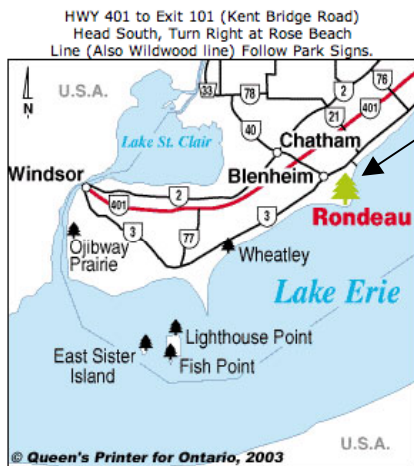
